

Fee list for items under Medicare that have additional costs

The following services will incur a practice fee that will be charged at the time of the visit.

Standard Consultation * \$79

Out of pocket expense will be \$40.80 - if eligible for a Medicare rebate. A Standard consultation is for 1 issue and less than 20 mins.

Long Consultation * \$120

Out of pocket expense will be \$46.05 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. A Long consultation is for 2 or more issues.

Extended Consultation * \$160

Out of pocket expense will be \$51.15 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. An Extended consultation is for complex issues.

Note: Telehealth Medicare Rebates can only be paid to patients who have physically attended the practice in the last 12 months regardless of concession status.

Telehealth Consult \$65

Out of pocket expense will be \$26.25 - if eligible for a Medicare rebate. A Standard consultation is for 1 issue and less than 20 mins.

Telehealth Long \$120

Out of pocket expense will be \$44.95 - if eligible for a Medicare rebate

** DVA, Pensioners, Health Care Card holders and children under 16 will be Bulk Billed for these consultations. During 9am-5pm Monday to Friday. Some doctors may bulk bill outside these hours.*

Home visit – \$80 call out

Out of pocket expense will be \$15.00 – If eligible for a Medicare rebate. Certain conditions apply for home visits please talk with one of our staff about these. Any additional patient seen will be bulk billed.

Iron Infusions \$160

Out of pocket expense varies – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. All patients requiring an iron infusion will be charge a practice fee.

IV Rehydration \$160

Out of pocket expense varies – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. All patients requiring an IV rehydration will be charge a practice fee.

Mirena Insertion \$200

Out of pocket expense will be \$69.85 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. Patients having a Mirena inserted will be charged a practice fee.

Mirena Removal \$120

Out of pocket expense will be \$46.05 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate.

Implanon Insertion \$140

Out of pocket expense will be \$52-\$74 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. Patient having an Implanon inserted will be charged a practice fee.

Implanon removal \$110

Out of pocket expense will be \$58.35 – if eligible for a Medicare rebate. Patient having an Implanon inserted will be charged a practice fee.

Fee List for items not covered under Medicare

There are some services that we provide for our patients that are not covered under Medicare. These services include:

Inactive/New patient Telehealth \$65

This fee is for when talking to one of our doctors via telehealth if you have not physically attended the clinic in the last year.

Cancellation Fee \$20-\$50

This fee is charged when repeated appointments have not been cancelled at least 2 hours prior to the appointment time or no notification has been given. Or in the case of Allied Health consultations, or a procedure.

Script Request \$15 phone \$10 online

Any phone request for a script will have a \$15 fee. This includes Concession Card Holders. We charge \$10 for scripts requested on our website.

Private Flu Vaccine \$16.50

We do at times stock private flue vaccines that we can give to patients who are not eligible under the government immunisation program for a free vaccine.

Commercial Drivers Medical \$150

This fee is for anyone requiring a commercial licence to drive. Further fees may be incurred if additional testing such as audiometry or ECG's are required.

Pre Employment Medical \$110

This fee is for anyone requiring a pre-employment medical. Further fees may be incurred if additional testing such as audiometry or ECG's are required.
